The Regions Rising events will be held in Charters Towers, Cloncurry, Hughenden, and Normanton in the last week of November and will link regional businesses with industry professionals and government services.

RDA Committee Chair and Charters Towers Regional Council Mayor Frank Beveridge said the locations were chosen to ensure a good coverage across the North West region and dependent on funding hoped more locations could be added in 2022.
